## **Pre-Club Prep**

Owls Carers may wish to pack snack /drink for Owls and to give these to Owls on collection at the end as we are unable to provide refreshments for the children at the moment. If your child needs to have water during the Club, please provide them with a clearly labelled water bottle, which will stay at their designated place until collection.

## **Arriving at the Club**

Owls and Carers to arrive at the patio at 9:55am and socially distance

Carers to attend the service at St Mary's Church if they wish to do so (carers are unable to stay at Owls due to current restrictions).

All Owls to sanitise hands before entry.

Owls to sit on entry at tables in two groups of 7/8. Siblings to sit together. Owls will stay in these mini bubbles for the hour session and will return to their designated seat after any activities.

We aim to keep the patio doors open for as long as possible before the winter weather arrives to increase ventilation. The skylight windows upstairs will also be kept open.

If your Little Owl wishes to wear a face mask, that is fine! Sub-group leaders will be masked up but Ali will not wear a mask when delivering whole-group presentations but will stand 2m away from the children.

## **During the Club**

The group will meet together as a whole (15 children maximum downstairs) for the first 5-10mins.

There will a starter sheet/ activity in their pack to settle. Currently, children are not able to share resources. (15 mins)

The sub-groups will then swap activities. Any equipment will be thoroughly cleaned after use of each sub-group if there needs to be a cross-over.

The groups will meet for the final 15 mins to hear a Bible Story together and to discuss this story. There will be a prayer. The children will finish with a colouring activity.

The Owls will sanitise their hands at the very end whilst in their subgroups before exiting.

## **Using the toilet during Owls Club**

Your child needs to tell their sub-group leader if they need to go to the toilet.

The designated toilet for all Owls is the Ladies 1st toilet. There will be a sign for this.

Only one child is allowed to go to the toilet at a time.

Anyone using the toilet must sanitise their hands BEFORE and AFTER using the toilet. There will a bottle outside the toilet for this purpose. This will be clearly signed.

### **Collection of children**

Carers to collect their children at 11am at the end of the service.

Carers to queue at a social distance on the patio.

Subgroup Left will exit via the Left Patio door and Subgroup Right, via the right. The subgroups will exit at different times.

Carers are responsible for their children on and after collection and need to be mindful of cars exiting from the carpark after the service. Carers need to be mindful of the need to risk Covid transmission and to avoid congregating on the patio for an extended time.

Carers may wish to provide drink/snack when they collect their child/children.

**Please let Ali know immediately if your child develops Covid-like symptoms after Owls Club and is then tested positive for Covid! Thank you!**
